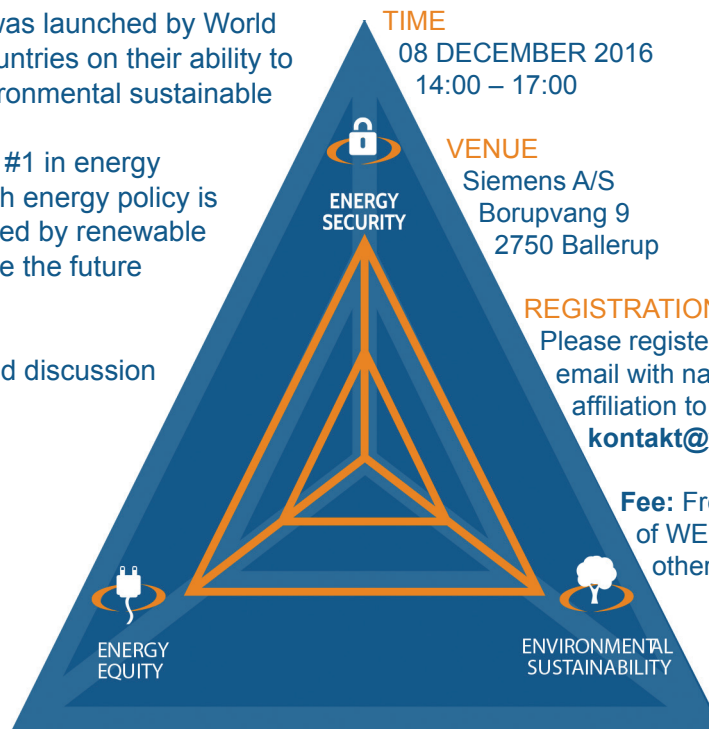
Denmark ranked as world's #1 in energy sustainability by World Energy Council
